## This Just In! Phone Scam... Don't Believe It!

Just as we were getting set to go to print on this edition, we received disturbing news from a customer and a bank employee who each received a phone message from someone claiming to be from "the Mortgage Interest Rate Reduction Department" and a phone number.

Our employee called the number and got the person who called but when asked, they said they were not allowed to give out their last name, the company name or the company address. Furthermore, this company was told by our employee twice that they are registered on the National Do Not Call List and the company responded that they could put them on "their" do not call list.

If you are registered on the National Do Not Call list you do not have to register



on someone else's do not call list. This company is in serious violation.

If you ever receive a suspicious call like this, protect yourself, ask them for the company name, the company address and if they say they can't give it to you, tell them you can't give them any of your information either! Then report it to your local police department, your bank, and the State Attorney General's Office.
